MESSAGE FROM LEADERSHIP



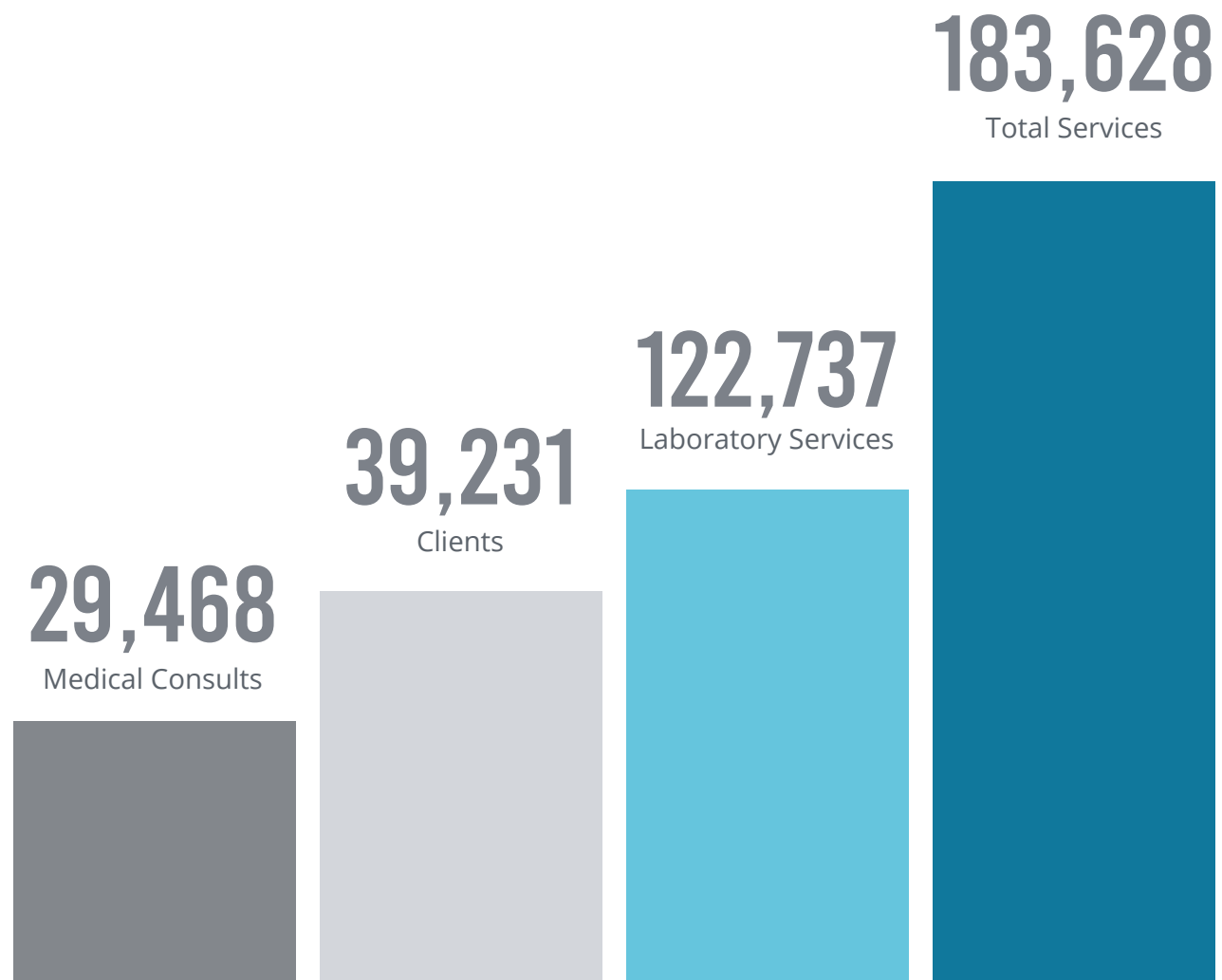

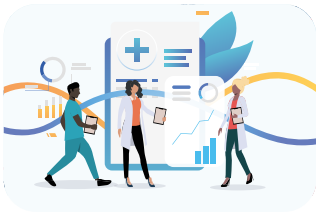
WHAT DID WE ACHIEVE IN 2021?



Clínica de Familia La Romana has a multidisciplinary team dedicated to the health of its clients. We provide a variety of medical consultations, psychosocial services and diagnostic services. In 2021 we had a 20% increase in specialized and primary care consultations, compared to 2020. In client satisfaction surveys, we achieved an average satisfaction rate of 93%.

GENERAL MEDICAL SERVICES



COMPREHENSIVE HIV CARE

Clínica de Familia, registered as an HIV care and treatment site with the Ministry of Health, provides free antiretroviral therapy y holistic care to clients with HIV. We aim to provide high quality care to adults, pregnant women in the HIV vertical transmission program, and pediatric care to children and adolescents.



"I have had HIV for 7 years. But I have an undetectable viral load because I have taken care of myself. The effort that Clínica de Familia has put into my well-being has not been in vain. HEALTH PROMOTION AND PRE-EXPOSURE PROPHYLAXIS

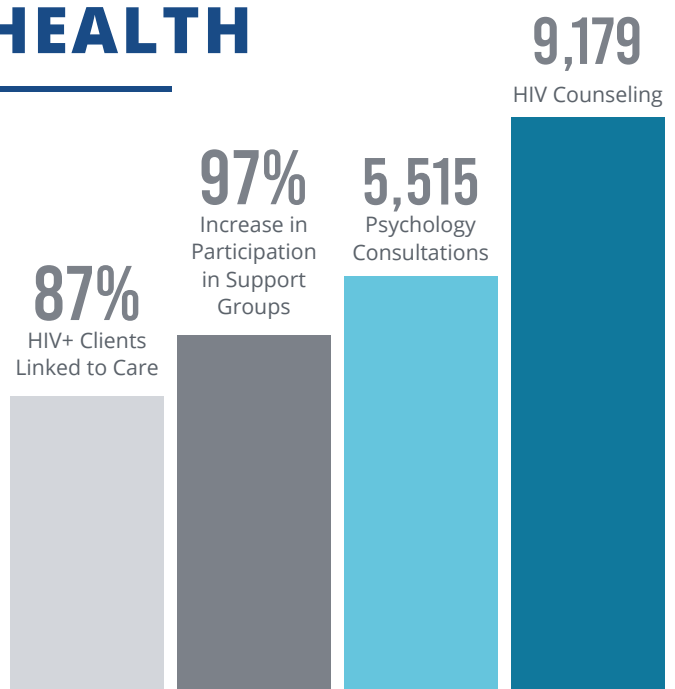


Clínica de Familia, committed to providing health promotion and prevention to the most vulnerable clients, offers them a comprehensive health care package with a focus on sexual health prevention, diagnosis and treatment of sexually transmitted infections (STIs), family planning, psychology, and health education.

The pre-exposure profilaxis (PrEP) program targets key populations, including men who have sex with men, trans women, and sex workers, to prevent HIV transmission. In 2021, 89 new clients were enrolled in the program, ending the year with 197 active clients.

MENTAL HEALTH

We have a team of psychologists to provide counseling and psycho-social support to all our clients supporting them from different areas such as: clinical psychology, pediatric psychology, adherence counseling, couples therapy, family therapy and learning assessments. The counselors conducted pre and post-test HIV counselors in the community and in our health center, helping to link people diagnosed with HIV to the HIV program.

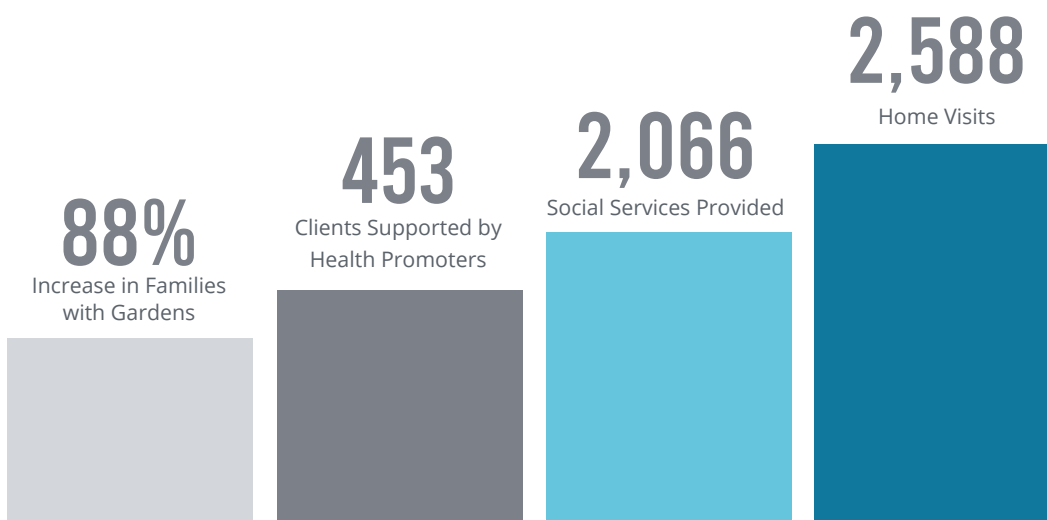


COMMUNITY OUTREACH, NAVIGATION AND SOCIAL WORK



Clínica de Familia La Romana has a community outreach team that makes home visits to the homes of vulnerable clients with HIV and in fragile health conditions, providing palliative care, health education and adherence support. We also have navigators who support clients with HIV with health literacy and adherence to treatment including: accompaniment to appointments, follow-up and assistance with treatment delivery, follow-up to medical appointments, phone calls, home visits, contact testing and referrals, as well as access to additional services as appropriate.

The social work department supported the most vulnerable clients, all of whom are living in extreme poverty. Socioeconomic evaluations were carried out in order to distribute available resources in an equitable manner, as well as food, medicines and school supplies, among others.



ADOLESCENT PROGRAM



The Adolescent Program implemented both virtual and in-person sexual and reproductive health programs in different educational centers in La Romana and bateyes, in addition to facilitating virtual groups of peer educators. There was a 33% increase in participation in the groups of health promoters, compared to 2020. The Community Family Planning Program nurse visits the community has a nurse who visits the community, both in urban and rural areas, offering family planning methods and education on pregnancy and STI prevention for adolescents and adults, free of charge. In 2021 there was an increase of almost 2000% in the number of clients receiving family planning from this program, as compared to 2020.



DERMATOLOGY CENTER



The Clínica de Familia Dermatology Center in Villa Hermosa offered clinical and cosmetic dermatology, gynecology, primary care, family planning and a clinical laboratory, providing 899 services in total. Despite offering a high quality service to the population of Villa Hermosa, we had to make the decision to close the center at the end of the year, for reasons beyond our control.

STUDENT PROGRAM



The student program received students conducting virtual projects throughout the year, with in-person rotations restarting in August 2021, after a suspension due to the pandemic. In total, 16 Dominican and international health sciences students, including medical and public health students, and medical residents participated in Clínica de Familia's student program. Each student conducted a public health or research project, in addition to rotating in the clinic's programs and services (for those students participating in-person). In comparison with 2020, there was a 13% increase in international students and a 33% increase in Dominican family medicine residents participating in the program.

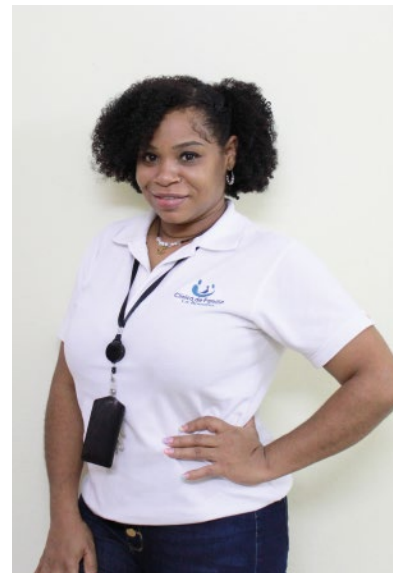
RESEARCH



Data collection was conducted for several studies in 2021, including for an evaluation of the pediatric nutrition program, measurement of adherence of clients with HIV, two mental health studies (one focused on HIV care and one focused on HIV counseling), two studies on the use of infographics (one in the HIV care for users with HIV and the other in counseling), and a study on global health research collaborations.

During 2021, four articles were published as a result of previously conducted research focused on reproductive health, health promotion and sexually transmitted infections. Research results were presented at two conferences (one in the Dominican Republic and one in the United States) and also at a virtual meeting on global health research.

FINANCES

In 2021, Clínica de Familia concluded the implementation of several projects, whose financing was received in the previous year, which is reflected in the decrease in revenue and increase in expenses. The surplus of revenue in 2020 allowed the successful completion of the implementation of all projects and programs budgeted for 2021. The financial team managed accounting records of revenue and expenditure in order to ensure that the different programs were implemented according to their allotted funding. This financial management was carried out in accordance with internationally accepted accounting standards.

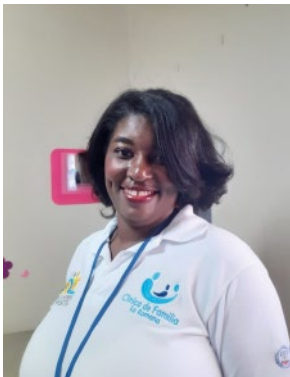

MISSION IN ACTION



Lilian is 47 years old, and she realized she was living with HIV when a community counselor from Clínica de Familia provided her with counseling and an HIV test in the community in September 2021. Immediately a community health promoter began supporting her, given her fragile health. Lilian had severe weight loss, inability to walk, dizziness and respiratory distress most of the time. In addition to starting antiretroviral therapy and medical care, Lilian also began receiving home visits and family

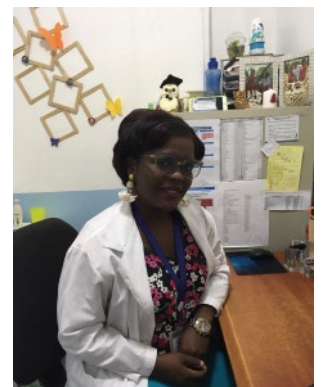
The treatment, the frequency of visits, nutritional support and the collaboration of the family allowed Lilian's physical and mental health to improve rapidly. By the end of 2021, Lilian achieved an undetectable viral load and began providing support in a family business, in addition to attending rehabilitation sessions, which improved her mobility. Both she and her family have expressed their gratitude to the staff at Clínica de Familia. Every day, Clínica de Familia is putting its mission into action by saving lives, just like Lilian's.



My name is Rosa Huber. In Clínica de Familia, I support our clients as a navigator. By helping others, your life has more meaning. This has been my main motivation.
